



ORIA RESEARCH UPDATE

The Ophthalmic Research Institute of Australia (ORIA) is a not for profit organisation dedicated to promoting research into the causes of eye disease and the prevention of blindness. The ORIA was founded in 1953 by a group of eye doctors concerned with the need to advance eye research in Australia. Since then, ORIA has distributed millions of dollars to advance eye research. The ORIA has a wide focus on supporting research into all major eye diseases, as opposed to focusing on a single eye disease.
